- ✓ A large peach has fewer than 70 calories and contains 3 grams of fiber.



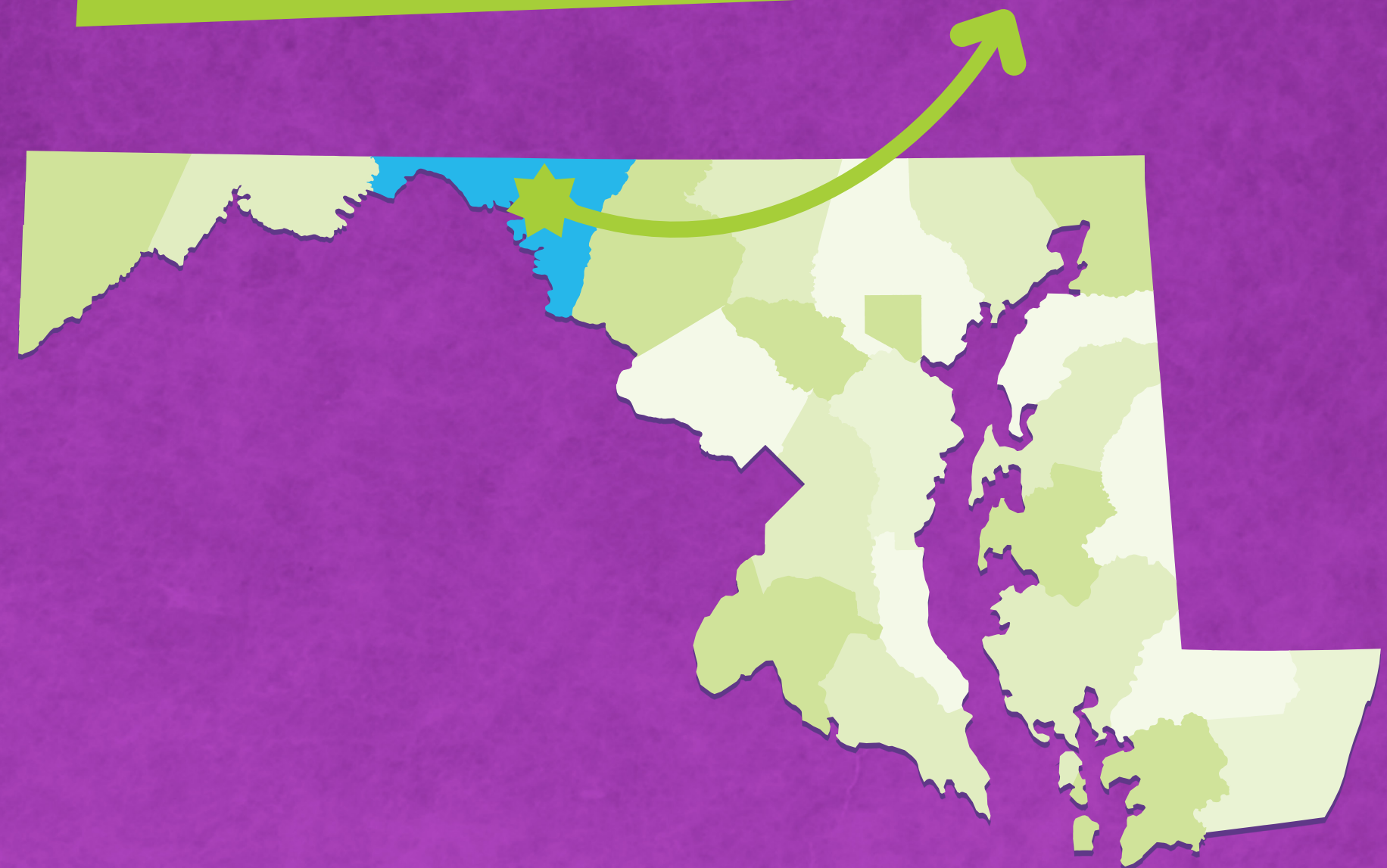
Featured Farm
