

NOTES TO THE TABLE / CHART ON THE PREVIOUS PAGE

1. If the current, appropriate deed is on file at the MACS office, then record both the agreement number of the application form *and* the liber/folio numbers under the General Comments section where the deed is kept.
2. Indicate all existing and proposed BMPs (noting which existing BMPs were cost-shared) and property lines. For sediment control practices, indicate the drainage area and direction of flow.
3. A NMP Certification form (only eligible for use in conjunction with imminent start up or expansion) is needed if the applicant does not yet have a NMP completed on his/her farm or if the NMP no longer reflects the current farming operation. The applicant must be in compliance with Nutrient Management Program (COMAR 15.20.08).
4. The current Nutrient Management Plan is required before project will be submitted for funding (unless operating under imminent startup. The applicant must sign the NMP Certification form). It does not necessarily have to accompany the application form (hence, the hash marks). Current NMP is required for Heavy Use Area Protection (Code 561) when installed as a confinement or feeding area or in front of a poultry house.
5. An On-farm Status Review is required for all expansions or repairs to 313 or 318. A Status Review is also required for any existing 313 and/or 318 if the applicant is applying for a 318. If the applicant is applying for a Poultry House HUA (Code 561) an on-farm status review is required for the 313 and 318.
6. This form is required only if someone other than the applicant went to the DBCF training. No payment of MACS funds will be made until the DBCF Training Certification form or a letter from the CES verifying training is received by the MACS office. This form does not necessarily have to accompany the application form (hence, the hash marks).
7. A plan view sketch is needed to graphically demonstrate the location, the design and layout of the proposed BMP.
8. The Extended Buffer Worksheet used as an attachment to the application form.
9. The applicant (or tenant) must be in compliance with the Nutrient Management Regulations.
